

# How to apply

for the 2024-2025 school year

- 1 Contact the Catholic school of your choice to indicate your interest.
- 2 Complete the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment online application at: [online.factsmgt.com/aid](https://online.factsmgt.com/aid) (Application fee required.)

Families should upload their tax returns and W2s from the calendar year immediately preceding the school year start date. Those who “submit” their application in FACTS by February 15 can attach the tax returns and W2s from one year earlier. Failure to click submit by the cutoff will result in tax documents from the more recent calendar year being required.

Additional support may be requested from those being considered for EISTC, to justify income reductions, household size above tax return size, income level unlivable.

*Incomplete applications or missing documents will delay aid processing.*

- \$ The amount of support is determined by the student's calculated need.
- ✦ These awards are available to students attending Diocesan schools.

## Making Catholic education more affordable for all

The McMahon Parater Endowment provides scholarships for tuition assistance to families seeking a Catholic education for their children.

- \* Both Catholic and non-Catholic students are eligible for these scholarships.
- \$ The amount of support is determined by the student's calculated need.
- ✦ These awards are available to students attending Diocesan and private Catholic schools.

### EDUCATION IMPROVEMENT SCHOLARSHIPS TAX CREDITS PROGRAM (EISTC)



## Significant support for eligible students

Through Virginia's EISTC program, the McMahon Parater Scholarship Foundation provides scholarships for students who are Virginia residents.

- \* Both Catholic and non-Catholic students are eligible for these scholarships.
- > Scholarships cannot exceed the state's allocation for the division in which the student resides.
- \$ To be eligible, families' annual household income must be less than 300% of the current poverty guideline (or 400% for children with disabilities).

Recipients must also meet one of these criteria:

- ✦ Are eligible to enter kindergarten or first grade,
- OR Attended a Virginia public school for at least half of the current or prior school year,
- OR Were not Virginia residents the preceding school year,
- OR Were prior recipients of an EISTC scholarship.

- ✦ These awards are available to students attending Diocesan and private Catholic schools.
